## EXPECTATIONS OF SLACC TEAM MEMBERS »

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### ATTENDANCE »

- **Wednesdays**

- Since we believe in the power of presence, we fully believe that it is for your good and for the good of our middle school students that you should come every Wednesday night that you are available. They may never remember what you said to them or did for them - but I promise, they will remember that **you were there.**
- We also recognize that life happens, and that there are many academic and extracurricular commitments that you all are involved in. Occasional absences are totally fine, but if we see a persistent issue, we may need to pull you aside about whether SLACC is right for you this semester. Establishing priorities will be a large part of your growth while a part of this team.
- If you cannot be here on a Wednesday - we need you to COMMUNICATE. Get in touch with a leader and let them know that you won't be coming. "No-call-no-shows" will not be acceptable - we want to be a community that can love, help and support you in the stressful times, not a community that you feel like you need to hide from.
- Being on time will be extremely important to the success of Wednesday night EPIC. Meetings will start promptly at 5:00pm and you are expected to stay and serve until 8:15pm. (Exceptions will be on case-by-case basis!)
- Bright Futures will be offered, but it is your responsibility to track them. Hours will be signed off at the end of each semester.

- **Sundays**

- SLACC team members are also expected to be active members of the high school EPIC community that meets on Sunday nights.
- We believe this time to worship, engage in fellowship, and be poured into will be vital to your ability to live a life of leadership, and lead on Wednesday nights.
- Again, we understand that life happens, so please just COMMUNICATE with us when you cannot make it.
- However, if you are struggling to come most Sunday nights, we may need to have a conversation about whether continuing to serve on Wednesday nights this semester is right for you.

### SERVANT LEADERSHIP »

- We believe that we lead by example. We are not in any way better than the middle school students that we serve...it is our joy to create as much of a positive experience for them on Wednesdays as possible!
- Looking silly and maybe a little foolish (for the sake of the middle schoolers) may come with being on SLACC team; we just ask that you have a great attitude and be a good sport about it!
- Ultimately, **Wednesday nights are not about you** - we have a whole night with a whole staff dedicated to fostering a fun and exciting high school community for you guys, but Wednesday night is all about our middle school students encountering Jesus Christ in a

real, tangible way. As a member of this team we believe that you are so important to making this happen!

- We expect everyone to be fully present in what is going on and to not be on their phone, constantly talking with other SLACC team members, etc.
- Wearing your SLACC shirt every week is so important! **Shirts are \$10 (due before you receive your shirt)**. Every student or parent should immediately know who they can come and talk to if they need anything by seeing that shirt. Also, having a unified look will go a long way in getting the middle school students to follow your direction.

## CHARACTER »

- Whether you know it or not, these middle school students look up to you, so how you act and what you say matters!
- Profanity, drug use, sexual behavior, bullying, and other inappropriate/illegal conduct is not inline with the calling of Jesus or with the culture we are seeking to create with SLACC and will not be tolerated.
- Your role as a SLACC team member does not end when you leave the EPICenter - you represent Jesus, EPIC and the church everywhere that you go. A great quote puts it like this: *“Your life may be the only Bible that someone reads.”* This of course includes everything you do on social media. You have a ton of influence, and an expectation of SLACC members is that you would not abuse this influence but would use it to point to Jesus.
- Since we believe that Jesus Christ should form the heart of all that we say and do, it is expected that each team member begins to take ownership of their relationship with Jesus. We as the staff are here to support you every step of the way!
- No one is expected to be perfect, but everyone is expected to pursue God and reject any and all sin to the very best of their ability.

I affirm all of the expectations listed above. I understand that being a member of the SLACC Team is a privilege and violating any of the expectations of ATTENDANCE, SERVANT LEADERSHIP and CHARACTER may result in temporary probation.
